In compliance with the Executive Order 11246; Title II of the Education Amendments of 1976; Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1972; Title IX Regulation Implementing Education Amendments of 1972; Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; and all other Federal, State, School rules, laws, regulations, and policies. Scott County Schools does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, age, disability or gender in any educational program including vocational education, daily activities or extra-curricular activities, or the admission to such programs or activities.

It is the intent of Scott County Public Schools to comply with both the letter and spirit of the law in making certain that discrimination does not exist in its policies, regulations and operations. Inquiries to recipients concerning the application of Title IX and its implementing regulations may be referred to the Title IX coordinator or to Office for Civil Rights (OCR). Title IX covers discrimination pertaining to athletics, sexual harassment, or gender primarily for the non-disabled.
