Are you using PowerSchool for Parents? Scott County Public Schools uses PowerSchool as our Student Information System and it allows us to track enrollment, grades, and assignments. Accessing the **PowerSchool Parent Portal** will give parents and guardians access to:

- View your child's grades in real time
- Email the teachers quickly

How Do I Access the Parent Portal? Contact the school secretary to schedule a time to pick up your child's unique and confidential "*Creating a PowerSchool Account information*" letter. This letter must be picked up by parent/guardian in person and contains the info to create your Parent Portal login. **You must have this letter before you can begin!**

1. Go to <https://powerschool.scottschools.com/public/>
2. Click Create an Account-here you will set up your username, password and link your students to your account using the information in the letter mentioned above.
3. Once the account is created, you can log in 24/7 to access your child's grades.



Can I use my Smartphone or Tablet? YES! Once you have created your online account using the steps above, you can easily keep track of grades and assignments from your mobile device.

1. Download the FREE PowerSchool MOBILE App from from inside your account when you log in (there's a download link) or by going to the iTunes or Google Play store.
2. Log in using your username and password
3. You must have the Scott County School District Code in order to complete your account setup. The code is **WKBG**
